84,000 malicious websites removed

As of 30th April 2021, the number of reports received stand at more than 5,800,000 with the removal of more than 43,000 scams and 84,000 URLs.



Things to remember with any communication

- ✓ Always question why someone is calling, texting or emailing you
- ✓ You are in control of who you speak to or respond to
- ✓ Know the signs of phishing – Refer to Action Fraud for current scams
- ✓ Never feel pressured
